## Letter of Intent for Student Internship Collaboration

WHEREAS, the National Taiwan Normal University Department of Chinese as a Second Language (hereinafter referred to as "Party A") and  $\circ\circ\circ$  (hereinafter referred to as "Party B") hope to create an internship program and strengthen bilateral collaboration and exchanges;

NOW, THEREFORE, both parties hereby agree to sign this Letter of Intent for Student Internship Collaboration and be bound by the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Party A shall refer CSL student teachers annually to Party B to assist in teaching Chinese and to improve its students' Chinese proficiency.
- 2. Student teachers recommended by Party A shall primarily be students of  $\circ \circ$ .
- 3. The two parties shall jointly organize a selection for student teachers on an agreed date each year.
- 4. Before the internship program commences, each student teacher shall sign an internship contract with both Party A and Party B.
- 5. Party B shall provide student teachers with the necessary approval or related documents.
- 6. Party B shall provide student teachers with  $\circ \circ$  (salary/benefits) as remuneration.
- 7. Student teachers shall be responsible for their own transportation, accommodations, dining, insurance, documentation/administrative fees, and any other personal expenses they might incur.
- 8. Before the internship program commences, the two parties hereto shall organize an orientation workshop or training course for student teachers.
- 9. During the internship period, Party B shall provide student teachers with the necessary guidance related to teaching and life support.
- 10. Upon completion of the internship program, Party B shall provide student teachers with a certificate indicating the duration, hours, and contents of the internship.
- 11. Party A may appoint its personnel to conduct on-site visits or evaluate student teachers' performance through a variety of other means.
- 12. Either party hereto reserves the right to terminate the internship for student teachers who violate the applicable rules.
- 13. The two parties hereto shall periodically review the relevant measures so as to improve collaboration.
- 14. This letter of intent shall take effect upon being signed by both parties and shall remain in force for a period of three years. Upon conclusion of the three-year term, it may be automatically renewed for further two-year terms. However, it may be amended or terminated in writing with the approval of both parties hereto.
- 15. This letter of intent shall be executed in duplicate, with each party holding a true and original copy for reference.
